STATE OF MINNESOTA COUNTY OF RAMSEY CITY OF NEW BRIGHTON

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NEW BRIGHTON CITY CODE TO ADOPT A PROHIBITION OF ON-STREET PARKING OF LARGE VEHICLES SUCH AS SEMI-TRUCKS AND SEMI-TRAILERS

THE CITY OF NEW BRIGHTON ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 29, Section 34 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of New Brighton, Minnesota, is added to code and shall read as follows:

Sec. 29-34. Large Vehicle On-Street Parking

No person shall park or leave standing a truck tractor, semitrailer, bus (except for school buses during normal operation of their weekday routes), truck having a licensed gross weight over 12,000 pounds, manufactured home, park trailer, travel trailer, trailer, or motor home, whether attended or unattended, upon the public streets in any zoning district unless in the process of loading or unloading.

SECTION 2. Chapter 29, Sections 35 through 37, shall continue to be denoted as "Reserved."

SECTION 3. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the city council, its publication in the city's official newspaper.
