AN ORDINANCE Relating to Traffic Control

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW BRIGHTON ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. New Brighton City Code Chapter 29, Article 1 is amended as follows:

Sec. 29-9. Traffic Control.

(1) **Traffic Officers Defined.** Traffic officer is defined for the purposes of this Chapter as the following persons: a public safety officer or firefighter employed by the City and official volunteers of the City, including members of the City's police reserve auxiliary, members of the City's law enforcement exploring post, or volunteers in the City's public safety unit.


(2) **Authorization; Penalty.** Police and traffic officers as defined in this Section are authorized to regulate traffic. Directions of a police or traffic officer take precedence over all traffic control devices. Willful failure or refusal to comply with a lawful order or direction of any police or traffic officer is a misdemeanor.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and upon its adoption and publication according to law.

Adopted this 24th day of August, 2021 by the New Brighton City Council with a vote of 5 ayes and 0 nays.
